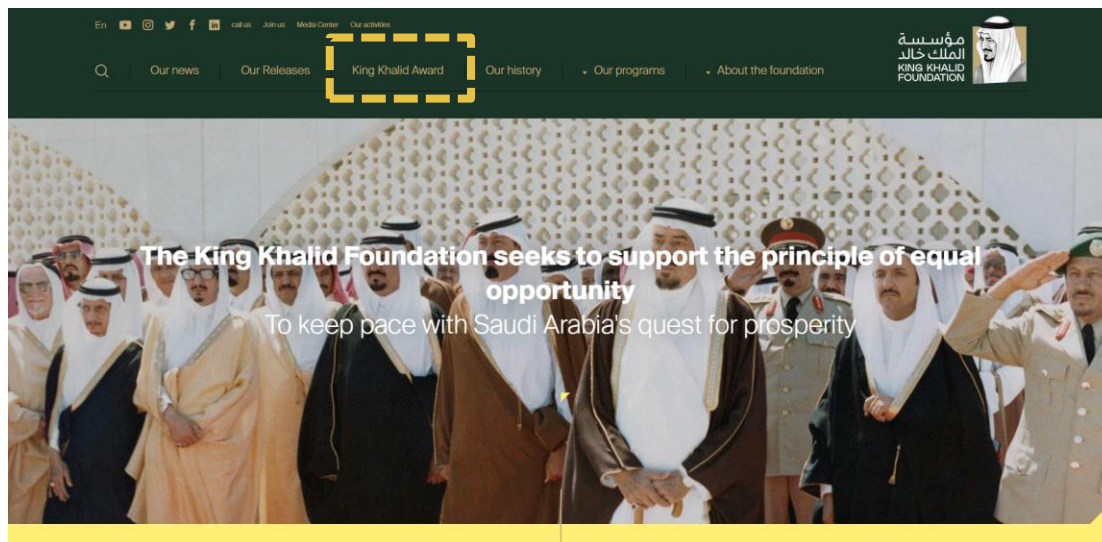
GUIDE PURPOSE

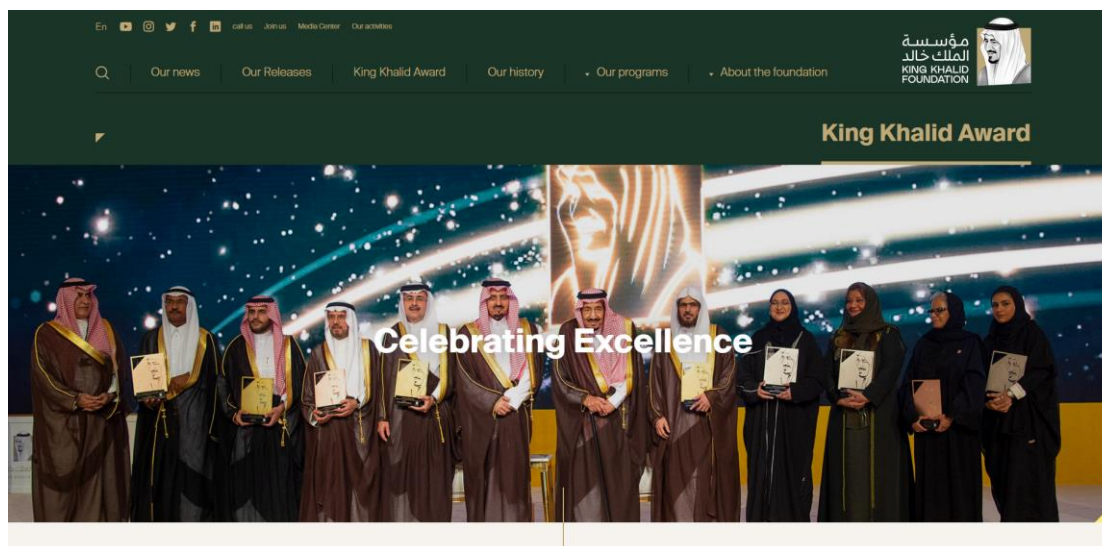

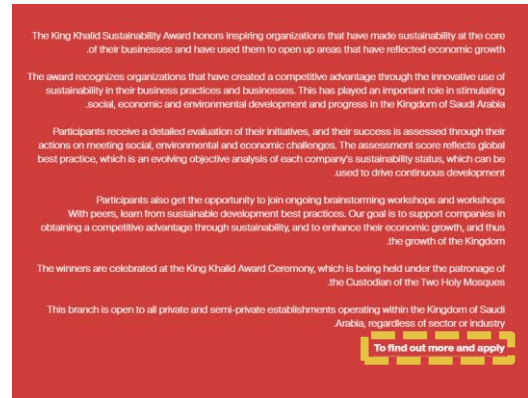
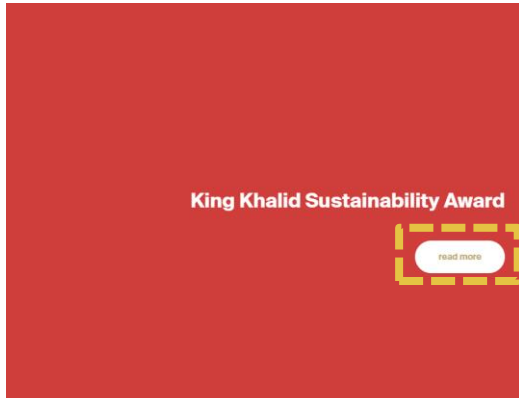
ACCESSING THE SUSTAINABILITY AWARD PORTAL

Please access the King Khalid Foundation (KKF) home page: <https://www.kkf.org.sa/>. Click on the “King Khalid Award” icon to be directed to the Sustainability Award page.

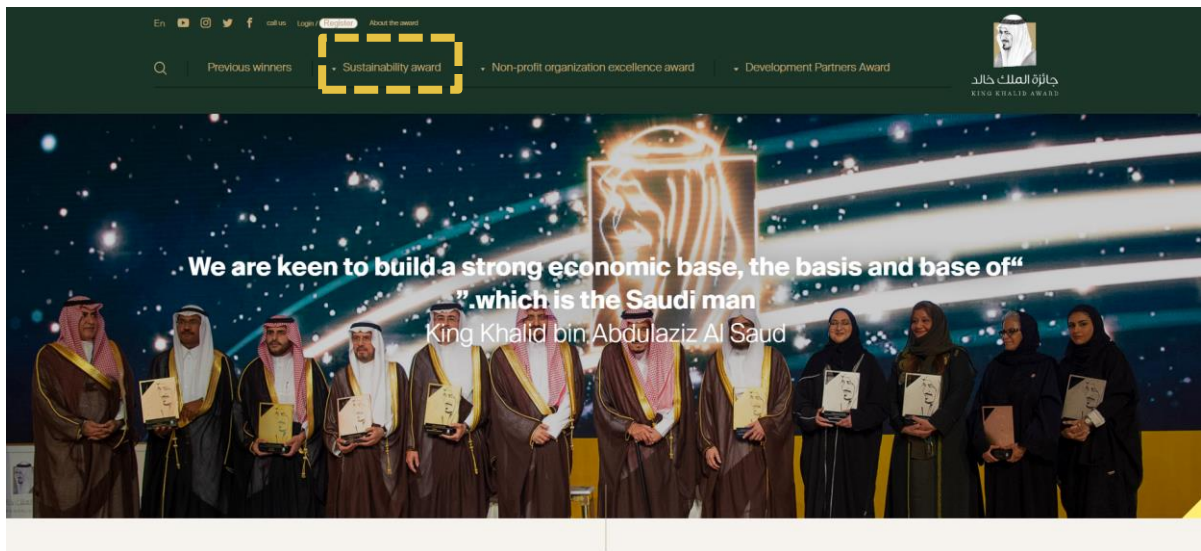


This will take you to the page below. Scroll down to “King Khalid Sustainability Award”, click “Read more”, and then “To find out more and apply”.



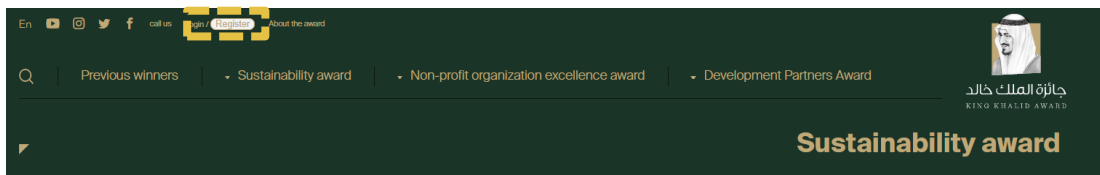


This will take you to the page below. Click “Sustainability award” to access to Sustainability Award home page.




REGISTERING

Upon accessing the Sustainability Award home page, click “Register” at the top of the page to create the log-in details for your organization’s application.



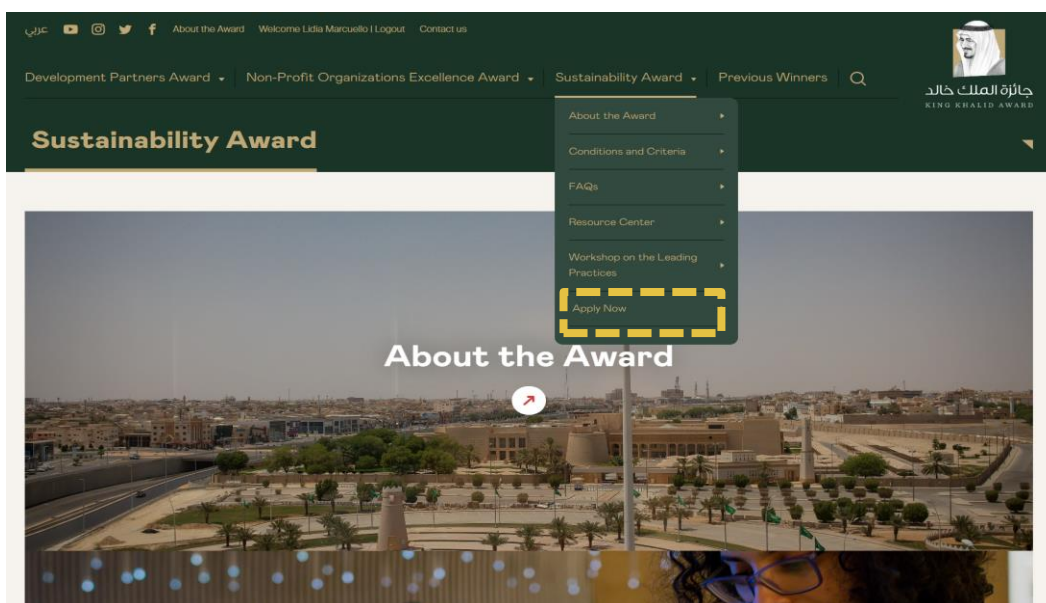
LOGGING IN

By clicking the activation link in the verification email, you will be taken to the Sustainability Award home page. Click on “Login” at the top of the page, enter your login details and click “Log In”.



ACCESSING THE APPLICATION


Once logged in, select “Sustainability Award” and then “Apply Now” to access Level 1 of the English application.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Before accessing the application, you will see information regarding the Award's eligibility criteria. The aim of this page is to help applicants determine whether they are eligible to apply to the Award. Please read the information carefully. Once you have read the criteria, click OK and you will be taken to Level 1 of the application.

If your organization is not eligible to apply, you will still be able to access the application and apply, however the application will not be taken into consideration.



Apply for Level 1

Eligibility Criteria

Who can apply for the Sustainability Award?
All forms of for-profit organizations can apply for the Award, regardless of size, industry and geography. The only prerequisite is that the organization has a corporate office in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, which can either be the company headquarters or a branch office.

Which types of organizations or industries are not eligible, and what are the alternatives?
Government-owned, non governmental, and non-profit organizations are not eligible to apply for the King Khalid Sustainability Award, but they are eligible to apply for the King Khalid Non-Profit Excellence Award. However, if an organization is interested to apply to the Sustainability Award, then a decision about eligibility will be made on case-by-case basis.

How can I know if my organization is eligible to apply?
Applicants shall be informed regarding their eligibility to apply once their application is complete and submitted to the King Khalid Awards team. Upon submission, our Awards team will assess your application and eligibility. A follow up email will be sent to the registration email account.



PREPOPULATING APPLICATION USING YOUR UNIQUE ID

COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM

The application consists of **four** main sections:

- ▶ General Information, including Terms and Conditions, Size, Revenue, and Industry*
- ▶ The four assessed sections of the Award:
 - Governance
 - Environmental
 - Social
 - Economic
- ▶ Brief Assessment of the State of Sustainability in Saudi Arabia*
- ▶ Brief Assessment of the Application Process*


You can use the “Next” and “Previous” icons at the bottom of the page to navigate the different pages of the application form. All questions with a red “*” symbol next to them are mandatory.

Registration

Before starting the first main section of the application, you will need to complete the Registration page. This page includes important information about the evaluation process, confidentiality, and instructions for completing the application. This section further provides the options to:

- ▶ Access the Award Handbook;
- ▶ See our Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs);



General Information


Once you have read and acknowledged the information on the Registration page, click on the “Next” icon to be taken to the first main section of the application, the General Information page. This section asks you to populate fields with basic information about your organization and contact details.



Assessed Component

The second main section of the application is the assessed component of the application. The subsections will ask questions about your company’s performance and policies across the Sustainability Award’s four core areas: Governance, Environmental, Social, and Economic.

As shown in the images below, there are a range of question types including multiple choice, Yes/No/NA, and open-ended text questions. Some questions may ask you to complete a table with quantitative information. 

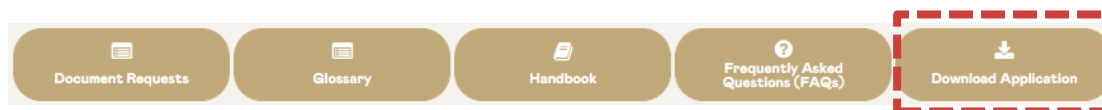

All data submitted by applicants will be used exclusively for the purpose of the Sustainability Assessment by the King Khalid Foundation and AccountAbility and will not be passed on to third parties. The individual scores will only be available to the applicant company as well as the King Khalid Foundation and AccountAbility for the purposes of the assessment. The leading Sustainability score will be public knowledge as it is included in the participant scorecards for all companies that participate. However, the individual scores of all other participants are not revealed.

Scores and data will be aggregated to overall and industry-sector specific averages and this data will be available for participating companies. General aggregated data about this year's questionnaire and assessment may be used in communications concerning the Sustainability Award. Companies can self-disclose their performance information in any of their own communications should they wish to do so.
